  - CF Area = over 1.22 million hectares (18%).

### Methodology


- Literature review

- Semi structured interviews, Field observation and experience



1. Hill-immigrants snatches the rights of Madhesi people











Fig. 3-6: the participation of different groups in the Community Forestry User Groups in Sarlahi
