Solidarity in a Competing World and Food Security Challenge

Abstract

Collaboration is probably one of the most important success factors for development. However, a combination of both competition and collaboration may be needed for sustainable development, especially under a number of current world challenges. Global climate change and increasing population challenges are forcing us to be more innovative in using scare natural and non-renewable resources much more efficiently and fairly, in order to achieve food and nutrition securities.
