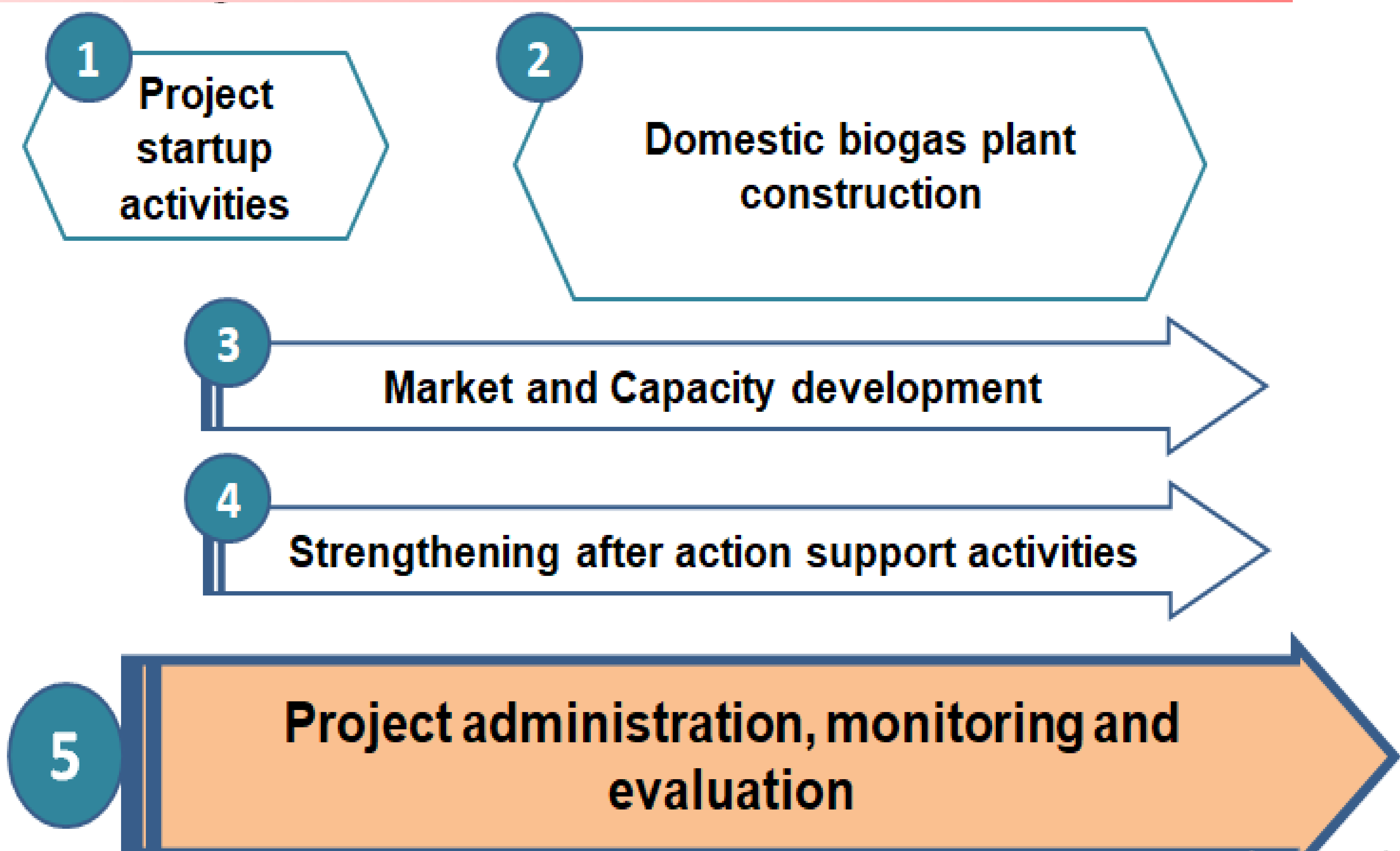
PROJECT OBJECTIVES
