#### **Methods**




Fig 1: Atacora map

### **Main Results**




Fig 2: Food outlets in Boukobe and Natitingou

### **Main Results**




Fig 5:Boukombe school food environment

Vegetables were available on 20.5% of food outlets and fruits on 7.3% only




Fig 6:Natitingou school food environment
